2020 was undoubtedly an unordinary year. Against all odds, CEO HI Partner Program* grew with many blessings. We love to share with you!

HI Partner CCC Project ("the project")

(CCC=Christian Central Church of Tsuen Wan)

The project began in 2019 Christmas when Senior Pastor Esther Chan ("P Esther") decided to adopt Dot-dot, our first CEO Social Work Canine (SWC) Intern. She then introduced the AAI (Animal-Assisted Intervention) concept to her Church by bringing along Dot-dot as her "fur-assistant" to serve the community. Although the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak restricted congregating in general, it became advantageous to our project that it enabled P Esther to spend significantly more time training with Dot-dot as "partners."

* **HI Partner Program** targets to promote animal-assisted activities (AAA) in Hong Kong and use novel means to support the local underprivileged communities.

P Esther and Dot-dot underwent our intensive one-on-one training. (Feb 2020)



After four months of the targeted training, we saw an impressive improvement in P Esther's dog handling ability.

Dot-dot had finally moved into P Esther's home. She successfully befriended the two felines and two feathery tenants under the same roof. (Mar 2020)





Dot-dot joined the mask-giving activity. She certainly did a great job attracting people in the neighbourhood to pick up the masks with joy. (Mar 2020)

Dot-dot helped to distribute Mid-Autumn Festival presents. (Sep 2020)

Some seminars were conducted via Zoom due to the 3rd wave of the COVID-19 pandemic.


Conducted CCC Dog-handler training sessions to selective staff & members to help handle Dot-dot in church activities. (Oct 2020)

(with Chinese Evangelical Zion Church Social Service Division)

We also arranged various work experiences and training (such as dog grooming and office administration) for the teens to help facilitate the reentering of society.






Online & Individual Engagement






11 Mar 2021: Guest Speaker: Mr. Johnny Yim, a renowned music director/producer/arranger. Topic: "My Atypical Career."






