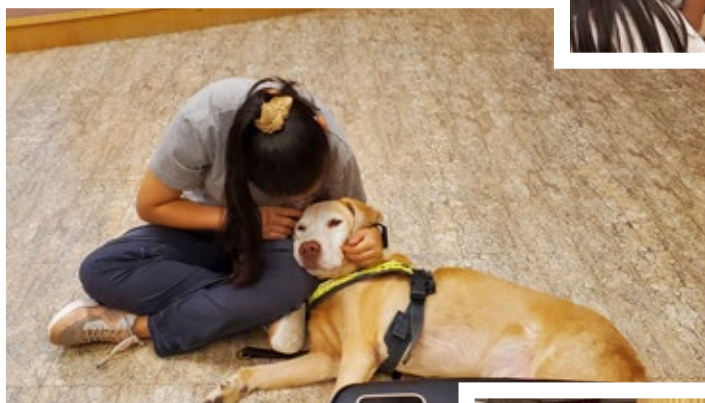

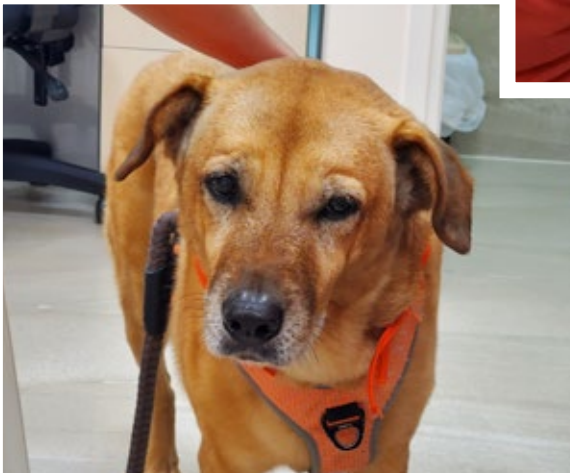

ACS Teens Give 2021

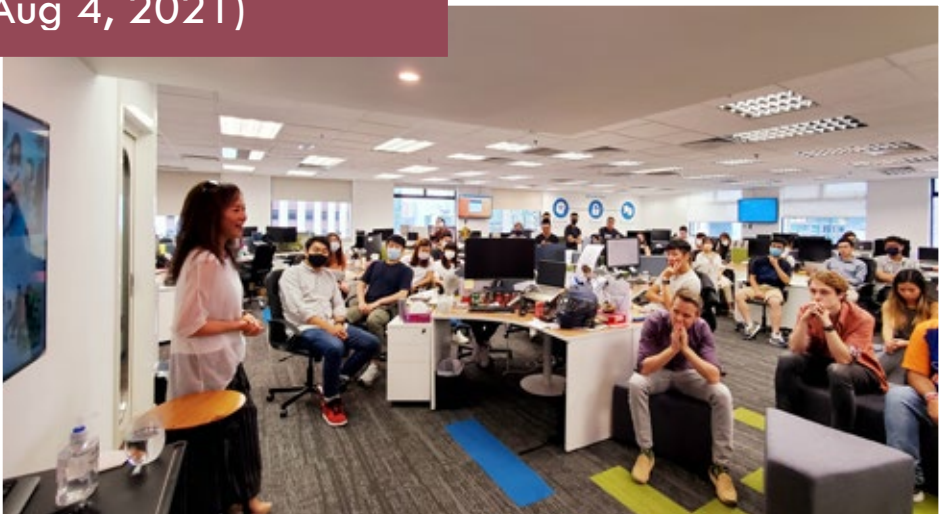

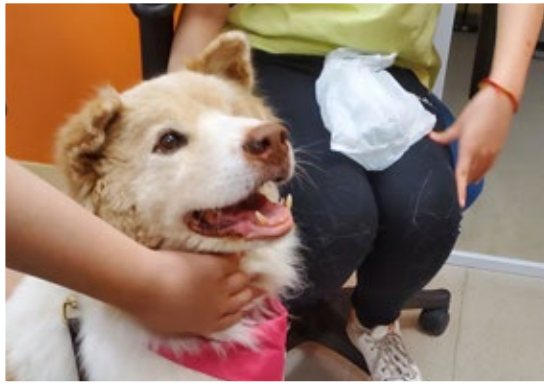
